ACP Group Statement on the appointment of the new Director General of the WTO

Thank you Chair.

I take the floor on behalf of the ACP Group to congratulate Dr. Ngozi Okonjo-Iweala on her appointment as Director General of the WTO.

We thank Dr. Okonjo-lweala for taking up this mantle. The ACP Group conveys special thanks to the Government of Nigeria for submitting her nomination and for that country's efforts in ensuring Dr. Okonjo-lweala's appointment.

The ACP Group takes this opportunity to commend you, Chair, and the Chairs of the DSB and TPRB for the diligence, confidentiality, integrity and professionalism that characterised the selection process.

Since Ambassador Roberto Azevedo demitted Office on 31st August 2020, the WTO Secretariat has stayed the course and continued its tradition of effective and efficient service to members. For this, the ACP Group wishes to thank the staff of the Secretariat and, particularly, acknowledge the excellent leadership of the Deputy Directors General during the interim period.

Not only are we pleased that Dr. Okonjo-lweala will be the first woman to lead the WTO but the ACP Group is also honoured that for the first time, there is a WTO Director General from the Group.
