

ACi works in five countries along the Cashew Value Chain: From Farm to Fork, A Win - Win Situation for all





ACi Vision until April 2016: Enhancing productivity and thereby increasing the annual income of small-scale farmers and processors.



430.000 farmers increase their family income by **\$600** (\$110 net) annually from cashew production; creating an accumulative additional income of **\$250 Million** (\$100 net) until April 2016
